ATTENDANCE **HIGHLIGHTS**

2018 was a great year to visit the Muncie Children's Museum. Our attendance topped 39,000 visitors! This is the largest attendance figure since 2003. Free Saturdays provide interactive, familyoriented, learning and fun for underserved populations in our community. In 2018, our Free Saturdays gave us 7,800 visitors which was the highest total since its inception in 2006. Thank you to our Free Saturday sponsors for providing excellent programs: Care Institute Group, Meridian Health Pediatrics, the Suzanne Gresham Center, Old National Bank and the Hamer D. & Phyllis C. Shafer Foundation. Our visitors primarily come from Delaware County, Hamilton County and several other counties in East Central Indiana.

DISCOVERY PARK **OPEN A FULL YEAR**

One of our most popular exhibits is Discovery Park, an exhibit centered on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) learning. It allows children to explore STEM through nature and play. Discovery Park opened on September 30, 2017. After a full year of operation, it is definitely popular with activities that include what goes in an emergency kit, how to choose the right pet, learning what animals are sitting in your back yard, getting up close to rabbits, guinea pigs, and chinchillas, learning to use a compass and more. Phase 1 was funded by AEP-Indiana Michigan Power; the Institute of Museum and Library Services; Ball Brothers Foundation; MutualBank Charitable Foundation; The Boren Family Foundation; The Terhune Family; and Kappa, Kappa, Kappa, Delta Phi Chapter. Discovery Park will be expanded in the near future.

LEARNING THROUGH PLAY (PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS)

Not only do children and their families enjoy the exhibits, they learn through play with the special programs we offer throughout the year. Annual events include a Pirate and Princess party, the Children's Health Fair, Spring Break Programs (Outer Space), Summer Programs (Oceans of Fun), Halloween Extravaganza, Family Fire Safety Day, and the Amazing Elf Adventure. 2018 was a very busy and exciting year! Our Director of Education and our educators play an important part in the success of these activities.

SUSTAINING FOR THE FUTURE "40 & FORWARD!"

At the Muncie Children's Museum, we believe that a child's success is not a function of grade level or test scores. Instead, success occurs every time a child finds learning enjoyable and non-threatening. 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
