













# Color Walk

## How to Make: Spring Chickens

### Materials:

- Paper plate, or white paper cut into 9 inch circle.
- Googly eyes, or white and black paper cut into circles.
- Orange paper for beak
- Thin strips of paper for tail
- Paint
- Glue
- Feathers (optional)

### Directions:

- Paint paper plate desired color. A quick blast with a hair dryer will help it dry quicker!
- Once dry, fold plate in half.
- Cut diamond shape out of orange paper and fold in half to create beak. If you don't have orange paper, use plain white and ask your child to color it orange.
- Glue eyes, beak, and tail feathers onto bird.
